Objective of Event:

The boot camp was designed to give youngsters the opportunity to practice creative thinking, drawing ideas, problem-solving, and idea generation through exercise. Such as imagination, game storming, and design thinking philosophy, all of which are achieved through the use of a strategy that is both practical and experimental.

During inaugural session Shri K.D. Patel Principal expressed the need and importance of such boot camps. The students were motivated to actively participate and share problems faced for which some innovative solutions could be obtained. The SSIP coordinator Shri D.B. Patel and Co-coordinator Shri A.A. Patel sensitized the students of the student startup innovation policy of Government of Gujarat and urged them to avail benefit of it by applying for this policy for any novel Idea/ Concept in their minds. The program was coordinated by SSIP Cell, G.P. Waghai-Dang.

Experts from diverse fields ran and oversaw the boot camp. In his two-day workshop, Shri Nitin Tailor, a young entrepreneur and motivator, explored ideation, creativity, and innovation prospects with students, as well as prototyping and group tasks.etc. Motivational Stories and Videos were shared during the sessions which ignited the minds of these young talent students. Students were assigned to them. Students were able to come up with new ideas thanks to hands-on training as well as novel concepts.

Workshop Outcomes: -

Students grasped the fundamentals of entrepreneurship and social entrepreneurship. They've been taught how to come up with new ideas, expand on old ones, and generally boost their creative thinking abilities.
